About Robert C. Adamski, JD

Robert C. Adamski, JD, brings more than 30 years of experience to the fields of estate planning, probate and real estate law. During his career, he has handled more than a thousand inheritance theft disputes, mostly among family members. Seeing the devastation families faced in the wake of these disputes inspired him to write his enlightening new book, *Inheritance Hijackers: Who Wants to Steal Your Inheritance and How to Protect It* (Ovation Books, 2009), to educate Americans on the dangers of inheritance theft—before it occurs.

Born in Waterbury, Conn., Adamski received his bachelor's degree from the University of New Haven in 1972, and his law degree from Western New England College in Springfield, Mass., in 1978. He relocated to south Florida, where he discovered he wasn't the only northern transplant in the sunshine state—droves of retirees were starting a new phase in life by making Florida their home. Adamski's law practice thrived as he helped these clients plan their estate, passing their wealth to beneficiaries while saving on taxes.

He soon began focusing his expertise on inheritance law and litigation, handling more than a thousand inheritance disputes in estates valued from a few thousand to tens of millions of dollars. After experiencing firsthand the permanent damage inheritance disputes have on the fabric of families as well as family wealth, Adamski recognized an urgent need to help people avoid the threat of inheritance theft.

With *Inheritance Hijackers* he provides a user-friendly estate planning handbook for anyone who plans to give or expects to receive an inheritance, revealing who steals inheritances, how they are stolen, why we are all potential victims and how to protect yourself from inheritance theft. Adamski warns that we are all potential targets of otherwise trusted family, friends, neighbors and associates who are motivated not only by greed but by a other motives, including revenge on a family member for a long standing grudge or old wound. Along with illuminating advice, *Inheritance Hijackers* provides quizzes, Q&As and checklists to help readers determine the security of their estate, which becomes more at risk as we age.
